In addition, Stephen Hernandez was officially elected as Secretary at our Quarterly meeting. Thanks to Fran Caldwell, our former secretary and Jim Boyd, our former VP for their help in moving us forward.

More great news - the Art League will be the recipient non-profit benefiting from the Downtown Hendersonville's annual "Bearfootin" program. John and Patsy DuPre, who are our first Bronze Sustaining Partner have teamed up with Walt Slagel, a long time supporter of the "Bearfootin" program to sponsor a bear for us. Stay turned for details on the design process and a call for a volunteer or team to do the artwork. The bears are revealed each spring, spend the summer on Main Street and around town, and are auctioned off each October. The non-profit benefit is for 50% of auction price up to \$3000 (\$1500)plus 100% of over \$3,000. This year quite a few bears auctioned for \$10,000.

A year ago, we had success with our Big Reveal fundraiser to kick off the opening of the Art Place Gallery. This December 15 we will hold another event, **"A LOTTO Art – Every ticket is a winner,"** which promises to be a winner plus A LOTTO Fun. Our artists will be donating work valued at \$250 or more (some into the thousands) and tickets will be sold at \$100 each. The number of available tickets will be tied to the number of works donated. We expect to have over 50 works, but we may have even more.
