

CALL FOR ARTISTS  
Library Exhibit  
September 30, 2022-January 6, 2023

Theme: "Through a Child's Eyes" – works that will attract the attention of all ages, containing elements that can start a conversation between a child and an adult about the subject, the artist, the color, or art in general. No commercial cartoon characters, please. Entrants must be ALHC current members.

To exhibit, artists must complete a [registration form](https://www.artleaguehvl.org) at the ALHC website, [www.artleaguehvl.org](https://www.artleaguehvl.org) prior to the closing date of September 23, 2022. There is limited space for this exhibit, and only the first 15 works registered can be accepted.

Take-in is Thursday, September 29, 2022, 11:00 – 12:00 at the Main Branch of the Henderson County Library, 301 N. Washington St., Hendersonville, 28739. The exhibit will remain in place through the holidays, and will close on January 6, 2023. All works are to be picked up between 11:00 and 12:00 on that day.

Works must be original, 2-D oil, acrylic, watercolor or mixed media. They must be appropriately framed and ready to hang (no sawtooth hangers). Maximum size for this show (including frame) is 36"x36".

Works may be available for sale by the artist, but **MUST REMAIN IN THE EXHIBIT FOR THE DURATION OF THE SHOW**. Neither the library nor its staff will have any responsibility regarding sales. If a sale is made, the artist must contact the Exhibit co-chairs for instructions.
