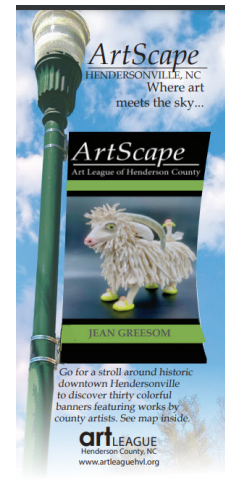

The Big Reveal of the 2023-2024 ArtScape Banners is just around the corner. Please join the banner artists and our sponsors at Art Place for a "Reveal" event Saturday, March 11 from 2 - 4 pm. This year there were 30 artists chosen for this annual public art project to grace the streets of downtown Hendersonville. The March 11 event will also include an exhibit at the Art Place Gallery of the original works. This is the first time both the banners and the artists' works will all be available to view in the same location. Thanks to Chair Judith Kolva and the entire committee for a great job.

Also, thanks to Michele Sparks with Art MoB for her hard work to finally get Henderson County on board for a Youth ArtScape Banner Program. 21 pieces of art have been selected from students in Henderson County for banners which will be hung later in March in Jackson Park. This program is supported by a grant from the Community Foundation of Henderson County.

Hendersonville Magazine Cover Opportunity

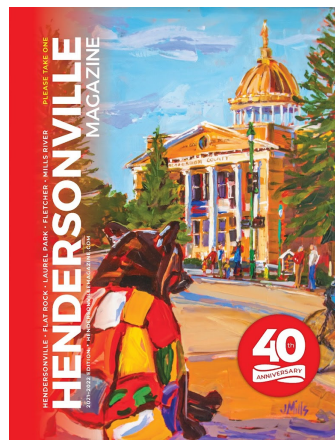
