Artist disaster recovery resources

By now, most of you should be aware of the resource centers for both supplies and connection with non-profit organizations, the Department of Social Services, and FEMA, who can provide a variety of resources. The supply center is located just off the Upward Road exit, Exit 53, of I-26. The services resource center is located one block north of the Art Place in the former grocery store building near Goodwill.

There are a number of artist-specific disaster resources, including a variety of grants. The State of North Carolina has recently committed additional funds to help in recovery aid for WNC. Here are some resources:

AVLArts - Emergency Relief Grant to meet the immediate needs of artists impacted by Hurricane Helene. The grant provides \$500 relief stipends to arts professionals living in the 25 counties of Western NC impacted by Hurricane Helene. The grant is intended for individual artists working in craft, literary, media, performing, visual, and interdisciplinary arts. WNC Artists can go to artsavl.org/aid to view full grant guidelines and apply.
